If remote families prefer paper order forms, please call the main office and schedule an appointment to pick up paper copies.


As a reminder, school breakfast and lunch are free of charge for all students in the Hazlet Township Public Schools through December 31st. Students order meals during homeroom each morning. Meals are picked up at the High School on Wednesdays between 11 am and 12 pm.
